Packaging: Outer contains 4 boxes, with each box containing (4 x 200g sachets), giving a total of (16 x 200g sachets per outer)


Mixing: Mix one sachet (200g) thoroughly in 2.0 litres of warm water (38°C)

Feeding: Feed via bottle/teat or stomach tube within the first 6 hours for maximum effect. Still beneficial up to 24 hours.

When to use

“FIRST FEED” (6 IN ONE)

1. Calves born to cows with no colostrum
2. When cow calves earlier than expected often with poor quality colostrum
3. When colostrum is tested and proven to be of a poor quality
4. High value pedigree calves
5. If there is any uncertainty as to whether the calf has suckled its mother, then ensure a “quality feed” in the first 6 hours or up to 24 hours
6. Late winter/spring born calves which can prove more difficult to rear
7. All twins or triplet calves
8. Calves born after a long and difficult calving
