Packaging: One kilo pack (20 feeds). Each scoop contains 50g of powder.


Mixing: Mix 50g (1 scoop) thoroughly into 170mls of warm water (38°C)

Feeding: Feed via bottle/teat or stomach tube within the first 6 hours for maximum effect. Still beneficial up to 24 hours.

Vitamin A	25,000 Iu/kg
Vitamin D3	3,000 Iu/kg
Vitamin E	90 Iu/kg
Selenium	0.2 mg/kg

When to use

“FIRST FEED” (7 IN ONE)

1. Lambs born to ewe earlier than expected
2. Lambs born to ewe lacking in colostrum
3. High value pedigree lambs
4. Multiple birth's (3 plus), when ewe may have put more into her lambs and less into the production of quality colostrum
5. Lambs born inside, later in the season where there is a greater risk of infection due to a build up of diseases within lambing pens
6. Lambs born after a long and difficult lambing
